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Post-operative Care for Minor Lid Surgery

- 1. After 24 hours, you may cleanse the operated area gently using moist cotton balls.
- 2. Tylenol (acetaminophen) may be used for discomfort. Please avoid aspirin or Ibuprofen as these may increase the risk of bleeding.
- 3. It is not unusual for the area to be swollen, bruised or red. You may also notice some bloody tears.
- 4. Ice may be applied to the incision for 10 minutes of every hour for the first 24 hours while awake. This will help with swelling and pain.
- 5. Please call our office if you notice any of the following:
 - a. Marked increase in redness or mattering
 - b. An unusual amount of swelling or pain
 - c. Significant decrease in vision (note that ointment will blur vision)
